The *New* International Code Council Foundation

The International Code Council Foundation (ICCF) is a nonprofit, 501 (c)(3) subsidiary of the International Code Council, Inc., an organization that develops and enforces the most widely adopted building codes in the nation. The Foundation enhances and supports the activities of the International Code Council and its members by achieving the goal of being the premier nonprofit addressing the safety of the built environment.



The Mission

The International Code Council Foundation is dedicated to changing the devastating effects of natural disasters and other building tragedies by promoting ideas, methods and technologies that encourage the construction of durable, sustainable buildings and homes.



Strategic Objectives

The International Code Council Foundation is dedicated to:

- Increasing consumer demand for and understanding of codes and mitigation as the keys to building safety;
- Supporting the building profession through creation of expanded access to professional training and education as well as creation of independent research opportunities; and,
- Creating community-based opportunities to connect ICC members to their constituencies and communities.



Management

Organizational Structure

The Foundation is a 501(c)(3) “supporting organization” of an affiliated nonprofit, the International Code Council, a 501(c)(6) corporation.

Governance Insurance

The Foundation board will consist of individuals & organizational representatives who have the desire to promote strong, safe and sustainable buildings.

Committees

The Board will delegate responsibilities to specialized committees made of ICCF partners.



Fundraising

The ICCF partnership formula is designed to provide a stable and diverse base of support to achieve the Foundation mission and organizational goals.

- The reconstituted Foundation will initially be anchored by a commitment of annual funding from the ICC with the goal of eventual self-sustaining funding.
- ICCF will adopt a tiered contribution system for Corporate Donors:

Platinum	\$150,000+	Silver	\$50,000 - \$99,999
Gold	100,000 - \$149,000	Bronze	\$5,000 - \$49,990

- The Foundation Board will also establish criteria for individual partnership levels and in-kind support to create opportunities for academics, other non-profits, and government entities.
